



Statutory Notice: RCO 244

TYNWALD CEREMONY (ST JOHNS) (NO 2) NOTICE 2021

The Department of Infrastructure gives the following notice under section 38 of the Highways Act 1986.

1 Roads closed to vehicular traffic

The roads specified in Schedule 1 will be closed to motor vehicles on the date and during the times specified in columns 2 and 3 of that Schedule.

2 Prohibition of Waiting

- (1) Parking will be prohibited on **Glen Mooar Road** (both sides) from the A1 Douglas to Peel Road to the A20 Poortown Road on **5 July 2021** between **8.00 am** and **10.30 pm**.
- (2) Parking will be prohibited on the roads specified in Schedule 2 during the period specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

3 One-way road traffic restriction

The roads specified in Schedule 2 will be subject to a one-way road traffic restriction and a person must not cause or permit a motor vehicle to travel otherwise than in the direction specified in column 2 during the period specified in column 3 of that Schedule.

4 Exemptions

- (1) Articles 1 and 2 shall not apply to emergency service vehicles, public works vehicles and vehicles approved by the organiser.
- (2) Article 3 shall not apply to emergency service vehicles and vehicles approved by the organiser.

5 Revocation

The Tynwald Ceremony (St Johns) Notice 2021 is hereby revoked.
