

#### **4. Management and Members' Standards Committee – Three Members elected**

*To elect three Members.*

*(Under Standing Order 6.4 the Speaker is ex officio chairman of this Committee. The previous elected members were Mr Quayle, Mr Quirk and Mr Robertshaw.*

*Under the Standing Orders of Tynwald Court the members of this Committee also represent the House on the Emoluments Committee and the Tynwald Standards and Members' Interests Committee.)*

**The Speaker:** Hon. Members, we turn to Item 4 on the Order Paper, the election of the Management and Members' Standards Committee of the House.

The election is governed by Standing Order 6.2, which provides that if the number of candidates does not exceed the number of vacancies, the candidates are elected without the question being put; but if there are more candidates than places, there must be a ballot of the Members present, and the candidates who receive a majority of the votes of those present and voting shall be elected.

I call for nominations and seconds to that. Hon. Member for Middle, Mr Quayle.

**The Chief Minister (Mr Quayle):** Thank you, Mr Speaker.

Having worked with the Hon. Member on this Committee, I would like to nominate our Deputy Speaker, Mr Robertshaw.

**The Speaker:** Do I have a seconder for Mr Robertshaw?

Mr Malarkey, the Hon. Member for Douglas South.

**Mr Malarkey:** Mr Speaker, I would like to nominate Mr Ashford.

**Mr Cannan:** I will second that.

**The Speaker:** Thank you, seconded.

Mr Thomas, Hon. Member for Douglas Central.

**Mr Thomas:** Thank you, Mr Speaker.

I beg to nominate Ms Edge.

**The Speaker:** Mr Harmer.

**Mr Harmer:** I beg to second.

**The Speaker:** Are there any further nominations?

Okay, well, I think that is three nominations for three spaces, so Mr Robertshaw, Mr Ashford, and Ms Edge are duly elected to the Management and Members' Standards Committee.
