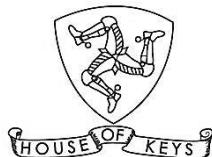

How entry channels at ports are assessed for aesthetic appeal?

3. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Glover) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What plans he has to deliver the budget in a different format; and whether Departments will be expected to adopt a priority-based budget model?

When he will publish the Office of Fair Trading report into Bus Vannin's demand-responsive transport service; and if he will make a statement?
