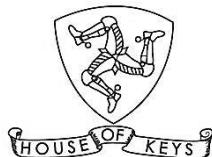

Whether a sinking fund has been established for repayment of the bond issued in September 2021?

2. The Hon. Member for Douglas East (Ms Faragher) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What his policy is on progressive taxation; and if he will make a statement?

3. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for Environment, Food and Agriculture –

Whether neighbours are notified when a tree felling licence is granted?

What consideration has been given to raising the threshold for adult bus fares from 16 to 18?

When she expects to submit for debate in Tynwald a report on space heating; how any such report will be prepared; and if she will make a statement?

What engagement there was with accommodation providers, and with other visitor-focused businesses, before changes to the Manx Grand Prix were announced?
