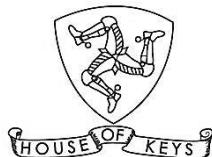

#### **1. Questions**

1. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

For how many days in each year since 2015 the MV Arrow has been unavailable due to a) use by other companies and b) maintenance; and how much revenue has been received from its being used by others.

2. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What the impact of a 0.25% increase in interest rates is on the cost of Government borrowing.

3. The Hon. Member for Rushen (Dr Haywood) to ask the Minister for Education, Sport and Culture –

When the new Special Educational Needs Code will be published on the register of business?

4. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Glover) to ask the Minister for Enterprise –

Why changes to dates for the TT and Manx Grand Prix meetings are not announced at least a year in advance.

5. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for Enterprise –

If he will make a statement on the 2023 TT timetable.

6. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Glover) to ask the Minister for Enterprise –

Whether a new scoreboard at the Grandstand will be in place for TT 2023.

7. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Ashford) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What progress has been made with introducing e-ticketing on buses; and what plans the department has to introduce online timetables which can be searched by individual stop.

8. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Christian) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What plans are in place for preventative maintenance of the gully and drain systems of the Island's roads; and which areas have been identified as key flood risks.

9. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Christian) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What the expected need for additional social housing is over the next four years.

10. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Chair of the Manx Utilities Authority –

Whether discounted electricity is available to domestic users.

11. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the the Chair of the Office of Fair Trading –

How many complaints have been received in each of the last three years from customers of Isle of Man Energy and its predecessor Manx Gas about issues with direct debit payments.
