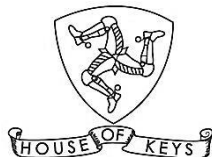

1. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Ashford) to ask the Chief Minister –

Further to his answer to W-202201-0410 given on 3rd November 2022, what the expected drop in expenditure is for each income quartile, and what the estimated remaining discretionary spend as a percentage of income is for each income quartile.

2. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Ashford) to ask the Chief Minister –

Further to his answer to W-202201-0433 given on 3rd November 2022, when work will commence to establish cost projections for a) on-Island electricity generation and b) importation of electricity for consumption on the Island ; who will undertake the analysis; when it will be completed; and whether the Government is committed to maximizing on-Island generation.

3. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Chief Minister –

What challenges are facing the DHSC and the health sector; and what action is being taken to address these.

4. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

What assessment his Department has made since June 2022 of the challenges faced by pensioners.

5. The Hon. Member for Arbory, Castletown and Malew (Mr Moorhouse) to ask the Minister for the Treasury –

On how many occasions in 2022 Social Services have provided an outreach service in the South of the Island to enable people to ask about benefits and support.

6. The Hon. Member for Ayre and Michael (Mr Johnston) to ask the Minister for Environment, Food and Agriculture –

What action she is taking to ensure farmers can supply stock to and receive payment from the Meat Plant in a timely manner.

7. The Hon. Member for Douglas South (Mrs Christian) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Care –

What the estimated cost of medicinal cannabis per individual patient will be to a) Manx Care and b) the patient, including any consultation, prescription issuance and dispensing fees and any other associated costs.

8. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Ashford) to ask the Minister for Health and Social Care –

What action is being taken to ensure people can access timely GP appointments and that calls to their GP surgery are answered.

9. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Ashford) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What progress has been made towards reinstating the footbridge connecting Douglas Cemetery and Noble's Park for use during race periods; and if he will make a statement.

10. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Wannenburg) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

What discussions have taken place with Loganair in relation to the long term sustainability of the Heathrow route; and if he will make a statement.

11. The Hon. Member for Douglas North (Mr Wannenburg) to ask the Minister for Infrastructure –

When the lower Johnny Watterson's Lane crossing will be installed.
