PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 615 (OLD FOXDALE RAILWAY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC) ORDER
1995

Coming into Operation : 12th January 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Footpath No 615 (Old Foxdale Railway) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 12th January 1995.

Closure of Footpath

2. Pedestrian and vehicular traffic are prohibited from using that section of Public Right of Way No 615 from its junction with Slieu Whallian Road, St Johns to its junction with Ballanass Road, Lower Foxdale.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until the 1st January 1996 or until the reinstatement is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrians and vehicles from using that section of Public Right of Way No 615 - the old Foxdale railway line from St Johns to Lower Foxdale whilst reinstatement work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the A3 Ramsey to Castletown Road or the Slieu Whallian Road.
