Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

FARRANTS WAY (CASTLETOWN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 23rd January 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Farrants Way (Castletown) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 23rd January 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Farrants Way, Castletown from its junction with George Lane to its junction with Queens Street.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the road resurfacing work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 6th February 1994, or until the road resurfacing work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Farrants Way, Castletown from its junction with George Lane to its junction with Queens Street whilst road resurfacing work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via George Lane, Castletown.

Access will be maintained to Queens Street from the Parade.
