Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY NO 412 (LAXEY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 30th January 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Right of Way No 412 (Laxey) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 30th January 1995.

Closure of Public Right of Way to Pedestrian Traffic

2. No person shall proceed along that section of Public Right of Way No 412 in Laxey from its junction with Baldhoon Road to its junction with Mines Road.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons engaged in the refurbishment work to be carried out to the MER depot.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 31st March 1995, or until the refurbishment work being undertaken is completed whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian traffic from proceeding along that section of Public Right of Way No 412 in Laxey from its junction with Baldhoon Road to its junction with Mines Road whilst refurbishment work is being undertaken to the MER depot.

An alternative route will be via the Main Road, Laxey.
