THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1986

THE HIGHWAY CLOSURE (PORT ERIN) (BREAKWATER ROAD) ORDER 1995

Approved by Tynwald 22nd February, 1995
*Coming into operation on the publication of notice of making the Order
in accordance with paragraph 10 of Schedule 3 of the Highways Act 1986.*

WHEREAS the Department of Transport is satisfied that it is expedient that the highway to which this Order relates should be extinguished for the purpose of enabling development to be carried out in accordance with planning approval, and that an Order under section 33(1)(b) and (6) of the Highways Act 1986 (a) should be made in respect of that highway;

AND WHEREAS the said Department has given public notice of the making of an order as required by Part I of Schedule 3 to that Act;

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the said Department by section 33(1) and (6) of and paragraph 12 of Schedule 3 to the Highways Act 1986, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Highway Closure (Port Erin) (Breakwater Road) Order 1995.
- (2) In this Order "the Act" means the Highways Act 1986;

Closure of Highway

2. The highway specified in the Schedule is hereby extinguished.

Apparatus of Statutory Undertakers

3. Paragraphs 13 to 18 of Schedule 3 to the Act, shall not apply to any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, upon, over, along or across the highway specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

HIGHWAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED BY THIS ORDER

That square area of highway in the Village of Port Erin known as Breakwater Road, from its junction with the western boundary of the RNLI Life Boat Station at the sea wall in a westerly direction for 7.5 metres, then in a southerly direction for 7.5 metres, then in an easterly direction for 7.5 metres and then in a northerly direction for 7.5 metres which forms a square which is more particularly edged by heavy black dots and a shaded area on the map annexed to this Order and marked "Map referred to in the Highway Closure (Port Erin) (Breakwater Road) Order 1994".

EXPLANATORY NOTE

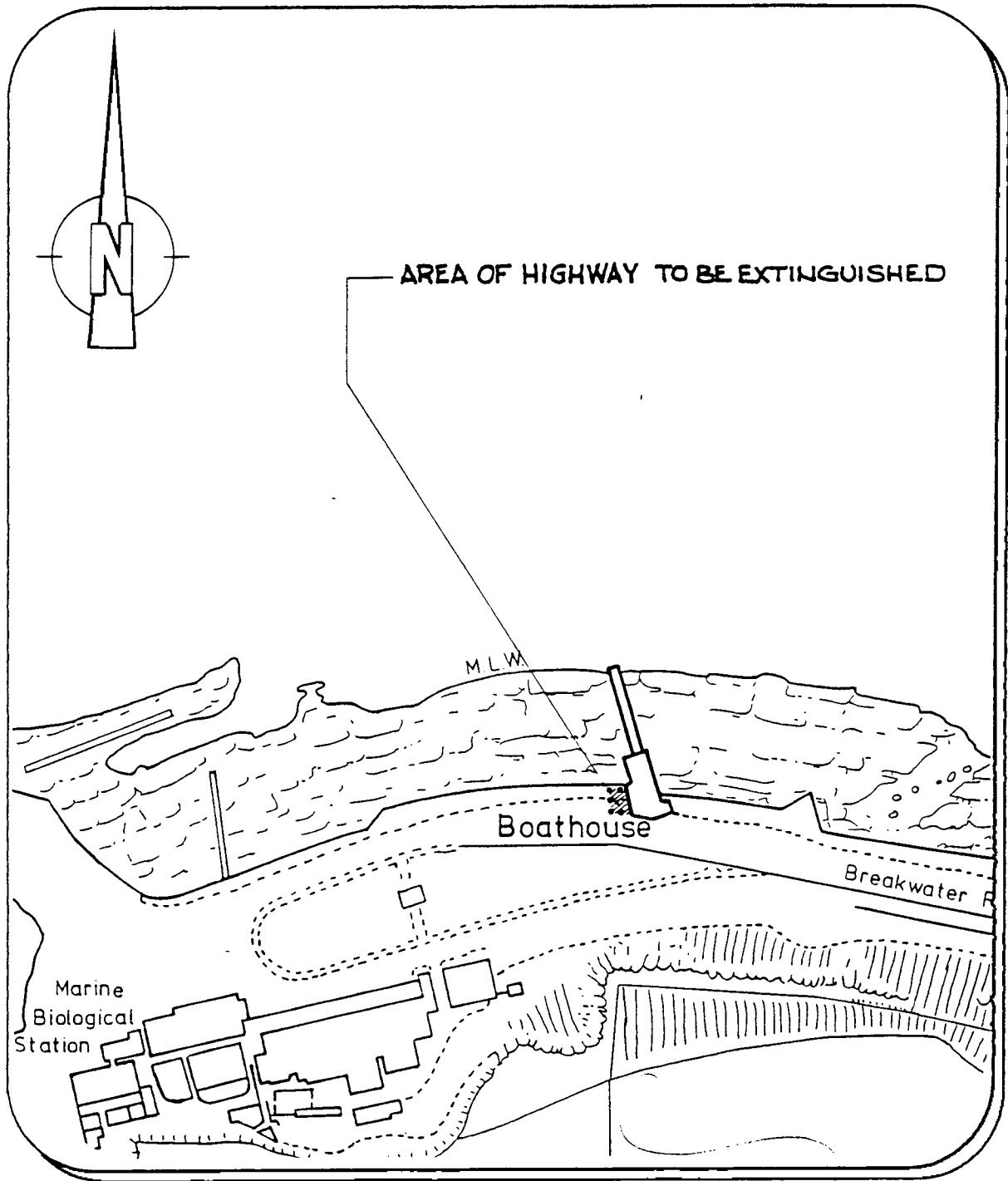
(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order extinguishes as a highway, a square area of Breakwater Road in the Village of Port Erin from its junction with the RNLI Life Boat Station at the sea wall in a westerly direction for 7.5 metres, then in a southerly direction for 7.5 metres, then in an easterly direction for 7.5 metres and then in a northerly direction for 7.5 metres and then in a northerly direction for 7.5 metres which forms a square.
