Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOILLEY SPITTAL BACK LANE (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 1st February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Boilley Spittal Back Lane (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 1st February 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the Boilley Spittal Back Lane, Peel from its junction with Peel Commissioners Car Park to a point abutting the electricity sub station at the rear of the property numbered 9A Boilley Spittal.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the electricity work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 8th February 1995, or until the electricity work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of the Boilley Spittal Back Lane, Peel from its junction with the Peel Commissioners Car Park to a point abutting the sub station at the rear of 9A Boilley Spittal whilst electricity work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the service road between the properties numbered 9 and 9A Boilley Spittal
