PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO 615 (OLD FOXDALE RAILWAY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN AND VEHICULAR TRAFFIC) (NO 2)
ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 11th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Footpath No 615 (Old Foxdale Railway) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic) (No 2) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 11th February 1995.

Closure of Footpath

2. Pedestrian and vehicular traffic are prohibited from using that section of Public Right of Way No 615 from its junction with Ballanass Road, Lower Foxdale to its junction with the new Foxdale School, Higher Foxdale.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until the 30th July 1995 or until the sewer work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrians and vehicles from using that section of Public Right of Way No 615 - the old Foxdale railway line from Lower Foxdale to the new Foxdale School, Higher Foxdale whilst sewer work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the A3 Ramsey to Castletown Road
