Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PARKING PLACES (PORT ERIN) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 16th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Sections 10 and 11 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parking Places (Port Erin) (Amendment) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 16th February 1995

Interpretation

2. In this Order :-

"Regulations" means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 made by the Secretary of State for Transport, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for Wales as they have effect in the Isle by virtue of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1982 (b).

"disabled persons badge" means a badge in the form prescribed by Regulation 3 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) Regulations 1992 (c)

Amendment to Principal Order

3. In the Schedule to the Parking Places Order 1965 (d) made by the Commissioners of the Village District of Port Erin, for entries No 19 and 20 (Station Road) substitute the following :-

"19 Station Road	As indicated by road markings shown in diagram 1028.1 of the Regulations	Northside adjacent the boundary between the Isle of Man Bank and the Commissioners offices - wholly within, the limits of the parking place	Monday to Saturday inclusive between 9.00 am and 6.00 pm limited to 1 hour. No return within 2 hours. Otherwise unrestricted	A Displaying a disabled persons badge	No lights required



No return within 2 hours. Otherwise unrestricted	A Displaying a disabled persons badge	No lights re- quired"
