Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

UNNAMED LANE AT REAR OF CHURCH AVENUE (ONCHAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 1st February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Unnamed Lane at rear of Church Avenue (Onchan) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 1st February 1995

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the unnamed lane at the rear of Church Avenue, Onchan from its junction with Church Avenue to its junction with Elm Tree Road.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the skip siting work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 6th February 1995, or until the skip siting work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the unnamed lane at the rear of Church Avenue from Church Avenue to Elm Tree Road whilst skip siting work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Elm Drive and Elm Tree Road
