Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY NO 321
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 14th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Right of Way No 321 (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrian Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 14th February 1995.

Closure of Right of Way to Traffic

2. No person shall proceed in that section of Public Right of Way No 321 for 100 metres past Arragon House in the Parish of Santon.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons engaged in the architectural work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 14th August 1995 or until the architectural work is completed whichever is the earlier.
