Coming into operation 10th April 1995

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. This Order may be cited as the Pension Supplement Scheme 1992 (Amendment) Scheme 1995 and shall come into operation on 10th April 1995.

Amendment of the Pension Supplement Scheme 1992

2. (1) The Pension Supplement Scheme 1992(a) shall be amended in accordance with sub-paragraph (2).

(2) In sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph 13 (interpretation) -

(a) after the definition of "Chief Adjudication Officer" insert -

"Contributions and Benefits Act" means the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 (an Act of Parliament)(b), as that Act has effect in the Isle of Man(c);

(b) in the definition of "qualifying benefit" insert -

"(e) long-term incapacity benefit under section 30B of the Contributions and Benefits Act."
