Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (MURRAY'S ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 20th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Murrays Road)(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 20th February 1995.

Closure of Road To Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Murrays Road, Douglas from its junction with Woodbourne Road to a point abutting the entrance to the Civil Defence in Murrays Road.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the water mains renewal to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 29th March 1995, or until the water mains renewal being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Murrays Road, Douglas from its junction with Woodbourne Road to a point abutting the entrance to the Civil Defence in Murrays Road whilst water mains renewal is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via York Road and Palatine Road
