THE JURBY SPECIAL DRAINAGE DISTRICT ORDER 1995

Approved by Tynwald: 21st March, 1995
Coming into operation: 1st April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by sections 2(1) and 4(2) of the Local Government (Special Drainage Districts) Act 1952 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Jurby Special Drainage District Order 1995 and, subject to sections 2(3) and 4(2) of the Act, shall come into operation on the 1st April 1995.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Local Government (Special Drainage Districts) Act 1952.

Establishment of special drainage district

2. The parish district of Jurby is constituted a special district, by the name of "the Jurby Special Drainage District", for the purposes of charging thereon exclusively the expenses of works of sewerage.

Transfer of district to Department

3. This Order is added as sub-paragraph (xxii) to section 4(1)(a) of the Act (which lists the orders constituting districts, the functions of local authorities under which are transferred to the Department of Transport).

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Revocation

4. The order made by the Isle of Man Local Government Board on the 16th July 1965 under section 2 of the Act constituting the Jurby Drainage District is revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note does not form part of the Order)

This Order constitutes the parish district of Jurby a special drainage district, and vests in the Department of Transport the functions of the local authority for the district relating to sewerage, and all sewers and sewage works in the district.
