Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (WELLINGTON STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH AND PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 25th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Wellington Street)(Temporary Prohibition of Through and Pedestrian Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 25th February 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No pedestrians or vehicular traffic shall proceed in that section of Wellington Street, Douglas from its junction with Nelson Street to its junction with the property known as Marks Cafe.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the crange work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 26th February 1995, or until the crange work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Wellington Street, Douglas from its junction with Nelson Street, to its junction with the property known as Marks Cafe whilst crange work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Regent Street, Duke Street (Except for vehicles on Saturday between 10am - 4.30pm)
