Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (MARKET STREET)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF ONE-WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 25th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Market Street) (Temporary Suspension of One-Way Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 25th February 1995.

Temporary Suspension of One-Way Traffic

2. The provisions of entry No 64 of the One-Way Traffic Streets Order 1981 (b) with respect of one-way traffic in Market Street, Douglas shall be suspended.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 26th February 1995 or until the crange work is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Market Street, from its junction with the former Drumgold Street, to its junction with the property numbered 17 Market Street, whilst crange work is being undertaken.
