Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (ALEXANDER DRIVE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 25th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Alexander Drive)(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 25th February 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Alexander Drive, Douglas from its junction with Woodbourne Road to its junction with Woodbourne Road Back Lane.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the water mains renewal to be carried out.

Duration

The Order shall :-

Come into Operation

25th February 1995  
4th March 1995  
11th March 1995  
18th March 1995

Remain in Force until

26th February 1995  
5th March 1995  
12th March 1995  
19th March 1995

or until the water mains renewal is completed whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Alexander Drive from its junction with Woodbourne Road to its junction with Woodbourne Road Back Lane, whilst water mains renewal is being undertaken over 4 weekends in February and March.

An alternative route will be via Queens Avenue and Hawarden Avenue.
