Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

LANE AT REAR OF BUCKS ROAD (DOUGLAS)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 24th February 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Lane at rear of Bucks Road (Douglas) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 24th February 1995

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in the lane at the rear of 126 Bucks Road from its junction with rear of 124 Bucks Road to its junction with rear of 128 Bucks Road.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the skip siting work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 25th February 1995, or until the skip siting work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in the lane at the rear of 126 Bucks Road from its junction with rear of 124 Bucks Road to its junction with rear of 128 Bucks Road whilst skip siting work is being undertaken.
