Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

A5 BALLASALLA TO PORT ERIN ROAD (BALLASALLA)  
(TEMPORARY IMPOSITION OF WEIGHT LIMIT) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 6th March 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Ballasalla to Port Erin Road (Ballasalla) (Temporary Imposition of Weight Limit) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 6th March 1995.

Imposition of Weight Limit

2. No person shall cause any vehicle which exceeds 7½ tonnes laden weight to proceed in that section of the A7 Ballasalla to Port Erin Road in Ballasalla from a point 50 metres east of the Ballasalla level crossing westwards to its junction with the entrance to the Silverburn Estate.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the railway track renewal and road reconstruction work to be carried out; or to emergency service vehicles.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 31st March 1995, or until the railway track renewal and road reconstruction work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic weighing in excess of 7½ tonnes laden from proceeding in that section of the A5 Ballasalla to Port Erin Road in Ballasalla from a point 50 metres east of the Ballasalla level crossing westwards to its junction with the entrance to the Silverburn Estate whilst railway track renewal and road reconstruction work is being undertaken.
