THE LOCAL ELECTIONS ACT 1986

THE LOCAL ELECTIONS (FEES) ORDER 1996

Approved by Tynwald: 16th January 1996

Coming into operation: 1st February 1996

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Local Government and the Environment by section 23 of the Local Elections Act 1986(a) and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Elections (Fees) Order 1996, and, subject to section 23(4) of the Local Elections Act 1986, shall come into operation on the 1st February 1996.

Fees and expenses for election officials

2. The fees payable to returning officers and other officials for local elections specified in column 1 of the Schedule shall be:-

- (a) in the case of an election of a councillor or councillors to represent a ward of the Borough of Douglas, the fees specified in relation thereto in column 2 of the Schedule; and
- (b) in the case of any other local election, the fees specified thereto in column 3 of the Schedule.

Revocation

3. The Local Election (Fees) Order 1989(b) is revoked.
