**THE REGISTRATION OF BIRTHS, DEATHS AND MARRIAGES
(FEES) REGULATIONS 1995**

*Approved by Tynwald on 11th April, 1995
Coming into operation on 1st May 1995*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Treasury by section 43(2) of the Civil Registration Act 1984(a) and section 51(2) of the Marriage Act 1984(b), and of all other enabling powers, the following Regulations are hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Regulations 1995, and, subject to section 43(3) of the Civil Registration Act 1984 and section 51(3) of the Marriage Act 1984, shall come into operation on the 1st May, 1995.

Fees Payable

2. The fees payable under each of the enactments specified in column 1 of the Schedule in respect of the matters specified in column 2 shall be the fees specified in relation thereto to column 3.

Revocation

3. The Registration of Births, Deaths and Marriages (Fees) Regulations 1993(c) are hereby revoked.


