THE CHILD ABDUCTION AND CUSTODY (PARTIES TO CONVENTIONS)  
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 1995

*Coming into operation*

*1st April 1995*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Council of Ministers by sections 24 and 35 of the Child Custody Act 1987(a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

*Citation and commencement*

1. This Order may be cited as the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) (Amendment) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 1st April 1995.

*Contracting States*

2. (1) In Schedule 1 to the Child Abduction and Custody (Parties to Conventions) Order 1993(b) (Contracting States to the Hague Convention), at the appropriate place in alphabetical order there is inserted the following entry -

"Cyprus

1st February 1995


(2) In Schedule 2 to the said Order (Contracting States to the Custody Convention), at the appropriate place in alphabetical order there is inserted the following entry -

"Malta

1st March 1995"

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order adds Cyprus to the list of Contracting States to the Hague Convention on the Civil Aspects of International Child Abduction (1980, Cm.33), and Malta to the list of Contracting States to the European Convention on the Recognition and Enforcement of Decisions concerning Custody of Children and on Restoration of Custody of Children (1980, Cm.191), for the purposes of the Child Custody Act 1987.
