Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BEACH ACCESS ROAD (JURBY)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 3rd April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Beach Access Road (Jurby) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 3rd April 1995.

Closure of Road to Pedestrians and Traffic

2 No person shall proceed or cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the Beach Access Road at Jurby from its junction with the Sartfield Road to its junction with the shoreline.


Exemptions

3 Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons and vehicles engaged in the coastal erosion remedial work to be carried out.

Duration

4 This Order shall continue in force until 3rd October 1995, or until the coastal erosion remedial work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note
(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of the Beach Access Road from its junction with Sartfield Road to its junction with the shoreline whilst coastal erosion remedial work is being undertaken.
