Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

Borough of Douglas (Various Roads)
(Disabled Persons' Vehicle Parking Places) Order 1995

Comes into Operation : 10th April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 14 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Various Roads) (Disabled Persons' Vehicle Parking Places) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 10th April 1995

Interpretation

2. "driver" in relation to a vehicle waiting in the parking place means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place.

"parking place" means any part of the roads authorised by this Order to be used as a parking place.

Authorisation and Use of Parking Place

3. The part of the roads specified in Column 1 of the Schedule may be used, subject to Article 4, as a parking place solely for disabled persons' vehicles in such positions on such days and during such hours as are specified in relation to that part of the road specified in the Schedule.

Other Provisions

4. (1) The driver of a motor vehicle using a parking place shall stop the engine as soon as the vehicle is in position in the parking place, and shall not start the engine except when about to change the position of the vehicle in or to depart from the parking place.

(2) No person shall use a vehicle, while it is in a parking place, in connection with the sale of any article to persons in or near a parking place or in connection with the selling or offering for hire of his skill or services.

(3) No person shall use any part of a parking place for the purpose of servicing or washing any vehicle or part thereof other than is reasonably necessary to enable that vehicle to depart from a parking place.

(4) The Chief Constable may for good and sufficient reason prohibit the use of a parking place during such times as may be reasonably necessary.

(5) The Department may suspend the use of a parking place on giving notice of seven days prior to such suspension


5. The Allan Street (Disabled Persons' Vehicles Parking Place) Order 1994 (b) in hereby revoked.
