Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (VILLIERS YARD LANE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 28th March 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Villiers Yard Lane) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 28th March 1995.

Closure of Road to Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic

2. No person shall proceed nor cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Villiers Yard Lane, Douglas from a point approximately 30 metres from its junction with Victoria Street northwards for a distance of approximately 65 metres.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons and vehicles engaged in the demolition work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 28th September 1995, or until the demolition work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Villiers Yard Lane, Douglas from a point 30 metres from its junction with Victoria Street northwards for a distance of approximately 65 metres whilst demolition work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the Villiers Yard.
