Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (MARKET STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 18th April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Market Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation at 6.00 pm on the 18th April 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Market Street, Douglas from its junction with Nelson Street to a point opposite the property numbered 17 Market Street.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the drainage work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 7th May 1995, or until the drainage work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Market Street, Douglas from its junction with Nelson Street to a point opposite the property numbered 17 Market Street whilst drainage work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the remainder of Market Street

The one-way traffic system over Market Street shall be suspended for the period this Order is in operation.
