Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HOPE STREET LANE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 17th April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Hope Street Lane ) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 12th April 1995.

Closure of Road to Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic

2. No person shall proceed or cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Hope Street Lane, Douglas from a point abutting the rear of the property numbered 35 Circular Road to its junction with Hope Street.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons and vehicles engaged in the construction work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 17th July 1995 or until the construction work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Hope Street Lane, Douglas from the rear of the property numbered 35 Circular Road to its junction with Hope Street whilst construction work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the remainder of Hope Street Lane.
