Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

A24 COOIL ROAD (BRADDAN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 22nd April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the A24 Cooil Road (Braddan) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 22nd April 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the A24 Cooil Road, Braddan from its junction with Vicarage Road to its junction with the B & Q entrance to the Spring Valley Industrial Estate.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the road works to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 23rd April 1995 and then from 29th April to 30th April 1995 or until the road works being undertaken are completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of the A24 Cooil Road from its junction with Vicarage Road to its junction with the B & Q entrance to the Spring Valley Industrial Estate whilst road works are being undertaken

An alternative route will be via the A1 Douglas to Peel Road and the A26 Glen Vine to Braaid Road.
