Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (YORK ROAD)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 23rd April 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (York Road) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation at 8.00 a.m. on 23rd April 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of York Road, Douglas from its junction with Woodbourne Road to its junction with Palatine Road.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the telephone cable repair work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 p.m. on 23rd April 1995, or until the telephone repair work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of York Road, Douglas from its junction with Woodbourne Road to its junction with Palatine Road whilst telephone repair work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Woodbourne Road, Withington Road and Palatine Road.
