Highways Act 1986

CASTLETOWN MARKET DAYS ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 11th May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order shall be cited as the Castletown Market Days Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 11th May 1995.

Interpretation

2 In this Order:-

"the Chamber" means the Castletown Chamber of Trade and Commerce;

"the Department" means the Department of Transport;

"market days" means each and every Thursday falling within the dates 11th May 1995 and 7th September 1995 inclusive.

"market period" means from the hour of 8.30 a.m. until the market is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4, or until not later than the hour of 4.00 p.m., whichever may be the earlier; or on 8th June 1995 only from the hour of 8.30 a.m. until the market is officially notified as completed in accordance with Article 4, or until not later than the hour of 1.45 p.m., whichever may be the earlier.

"market site" means the area of roadway set out and described in the schedule.

Closure of Road and Temporary Suspension and Regulation of Traffic

3 On the market days during the market period the market site may be closed to, and the right of vehicular traffic to proceed thereover suspended for all vehicular traffic, other than such traffic as may be authorised by the Chamber or the Chief Constable.

Erection of Barriers

4 During the market period the Chamber may cause barriers to be erected and maintained at or near the junction of the market site

with those roads leading into the market site. Such barriers to be dismantled and removed immediately after the conclusion of the market period.

Erection of Stalls

5 During the market period the Chamber may permit persons to erect stalls on the market site subject to compliance with the terms of any licence issued by the Castletown Commissioners.

Duty of Chamber to notify completion of Market

6 It shall be the duty of the Chamber to make such provisions as seems most expedient for giving official notification to the public of the conclusion of the market and of the opening of the market site to traffic.

Notice of the Making of the Order

7 Public notice of this Order shall be given in one Isle of Man Newspaper.

SCHEDULE

The whole of that area of Market Square, Castletown, situated on the northern side of the Smelt monument as indicated by barriers erected thereon.
