The Highways Act 1986

**THE HIGHWAY CLOSURE (DOUGLAS)
(SHERWOOD TERRACE LANE) ORDER 1995**

Approved by Tynwald 16th May, 1995

Coming into operation on the publication of notice of making the Order in accordance with paragraph 10 of Schedule 3 of the Highways Act 1986

WHEREAS the Department of Transport is satisfied that on the grounds that it is not needed for public use it is expedient that the highway to which this Order relates should be extinguished, and that an Order under Section 33(1)(a) of the Highways Act 1986 (a) should be made in respect of that highway.

AND WHEREAS the said Department has given public notice of the making of an Order as required by Part I of Schedule 3 to that Act;

IN exercise of the powers conferred on the said Department by Section 33(1) and paragraph 12 of Schedule 3 to the Highways Act 1986, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Highway Closure (Douglas) (Sherwood Terrace Lane) Order 1995.

(2) In this Order "the Act" means the Highways Act 1986.

Closure of Highway

2. The highway specified in the Schedule is hereby extinguished.

Apparatus of Statutory Undertakers

3. Paragraphs 13 to 18 of Schedule 3 to the Act, shall not apply to any apparatus of statutory undertakers under, in, upon, over, along or across the highway specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

HIGHWAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED BY THIS ORDER

That length of highway in the Borough of Douglas known as Sherwood Terrace Lane, from its junction with the eastern boundary (at the rear) of the property numbered 7 Sherwood Terrace (on Broadway) westwards to its junction with the western boundary (at the rear) of the property numbered 8 Sherwood Terrace, which is more particularly shown by heavy black dots on the map annexed to this Order and marked "map referred to in the Highway Closure (Douglas) (Sherwood Terrace Lane) Order 1995".

Explanatory Note

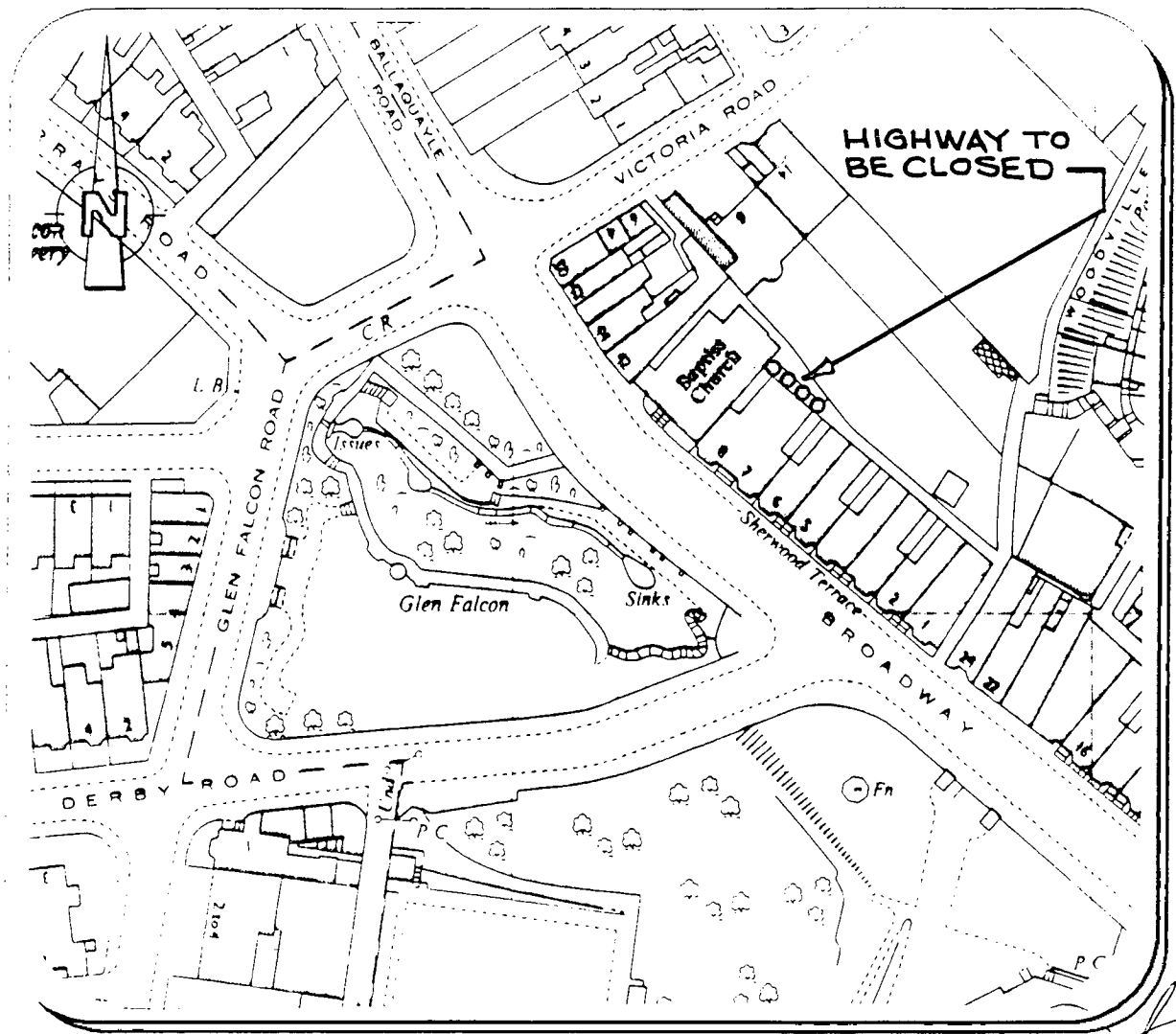
(This note is not a part of the Order)

This Order extinguishes as a highway, a part of Sherwood Terrace Lane in the Borough of Douglas from its junction with the boundary (at the rear) of the property numbered 7 Sherwood Terrace (on Broadway) westwards to its junction with the western boundary (at the rear) of the property numbered 8 Sherwood Terrace.

Subject to approval of Tynwald, the Order comes into effect on the publication of notice of making of the Order in accordance with Schedule 3 of the Highways Act 1986.
