Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (CRELLINS HILL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 1st May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Crellins Hill) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 1st May 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Crellins Hill, Douglas from its junction with Finch Road to its junction with Kingswood Grove.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the sewer work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 19th May 1995, or until the sewer work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Crellins Hill, Douglas from its junction with Finch Road to its junction with Kingswood Grove whilst sewer work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be Finch Road, Christian Road and Kingswood Grove or Albert Terrace, Albion Terrace, Derby Square, Derby Road, Broadway, Harris Promenade and Church Road.
