Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

TOWN OF CASTLETOWN (QUEEN STREET)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation : 6th May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Town of Castletown (Queen Street) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 6th May 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Queen Street, Castletown from its junction with the Parade for a distance of approximately 50 metres.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the excavation work to be carried out.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 7th May 1995, or until the excavation work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Queen Street, Castletown from its junction with the Parade for a distance of 50 metres, whilst excavation work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the George Back Lane.
