Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

DOUGLAS STREET (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 14th May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Douglas Street (Peel) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation at 8.00 am on 14th May 1995.

Closure of Road to Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Douglas Street, Peel from its junction with Market Place to a point abutting the Douglas Street Car Park.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the gas pipe laying work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 6.00 pm on 14th May 1995 or until the gas pipe laying work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Douglas Street, Peel from its junction with Market Place to a point abutting the Douglas Street Car Park whilst gas pipe laying work is being undertaken.

The one-way traffic system on Douglas Street shall be suspended for the period this Order has effect

An alternative route will be via Patrick Street and Heathfield Drive.
