Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

PARISH OF MAROWN (GLEN VINE ROAD, GLEN VINE)  
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 9th May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Parish of Marown (Glen Vine Road, Glen Vine) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 9th May 1995.

Closure of Road to Vehicular Traffic

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of the Glen Vine Road in the Parish of Marown from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road in Glen Vine to its junction with the Ballagarey Road.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to vehicles engaged in the trench reinstatement work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 23rd May 1995 or until the trench reinstatement work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of the Glen Vine Road in the Parish of Marown from its junction with the A1 Douglas to Peel Road in Glen Vine to its junction with the Ballagarey Road whilst trench reinstatement work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via the Ballagarey Road
