Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

EAST QUAY (PEEL)
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 1st May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the East Quay (Peel) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1995.

One-Way Traffic

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a southerly direction over East Quay, Peel from its junction with Station Place to its junction with Mill Road.


Illumination Exception

3. The provisions of regulation 15 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1981 of Parliament, as applied in the Isle of Man by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 1982 (b) (which prescribe, inter alia, that certain signs shall be illuminated throughout the hours of darkness by means of internal or external lighting) shall not apply in the case of traffic signs erected to indicate the effect of this Order.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until 31st October 1995

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in a southerly direction only over East Quay, Peel
