Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (HILL STREET LANE)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation :- 15th May 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Hill Street Lane) (Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 15th May 1995.

Closure of Road to Pedestrian and Vehicular Traffic

2. No person shall proceed nor cause any vehicle to proceed in that section of Hill Street Lane, Douglas from its junction with Hill Street to a point abutting the rear of the property numbered 13 Hill Street.

Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply to persons or vehicles engaged in the demolition and drainage work to be carried out.

Duration

4. The Order shall continue in force until 3rd July 1995, or until the demolition and drainage work being undertaken is completed, whichever is the earlier.

Explanatory Note

(This note is not a part of the Order)

The effect of this Order is to prohibit pedestrian and vehicular traffic from proceeding in that section of Hill Street Lane, Douglas from its junction with Hill Street to a point abutting the rear of No 13 Hill Street whilst demolition and drainage work is being undertaken.

An alternative route will be via Hill Street and Upper Church Street, Douglas.
