THE MOTOR VEHICLES (AUTHORISATION OF SPECIAL TYPES)
(RAMSEY SPRINT) ORDER 1995

Coming into operation 6th June 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by paragraph 3 (1) (a) and (2) of Schedule 2 to the Road Traffic Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation, duration and interpretation

1. (1) This Order may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Authorisation of Special Types) (Ramsey Sprint) Order 1995 and shall have effect for 6th June 1995 only.

(2) In this Order :-

"the Course", "practice period" and "race period" have the same meanings as in the Road Race Order.

"promoter" means Myatt McFarlane PLC.

"race" has the same meaning as in the Road Races Act 1982 (b);

"the Road Race Order" means the Ramsey Sprint Order 1995 (c).

Authorisation of use of certain motor cycles

2. (1) This article applies to a motor cycle with or without a sidecar which-

(a) is accepted by the promoter of a race authorised by the Road Race Order for competition in or practice for that race, and

(b) does not comply with all the requirements of the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations 1979 (d) and the Road Vehicles Lighting Regulations 1992 (e).

(2) The use on roads of a vehicle to which this article applies is authorised subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph (3).

(3) The vehicle may not be used except -

(a) during a period commencing 3 hours before any practice period or before the race period applicable to the race referred to in paragraph (1)(a) and ending 2 hours after that practice period or race period; and

(b) on a journey between the place where it is kept and the start of the Course, or from a point on the Course, to the place where it is kept or between points on the Course.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not a part of the Order)

This temporary Order authorises the use on a road to or from a race or practice forming part of the Ramsey Sprint races of a motor cycle taking part in the race or practice, although it may not comply with the construction and lighting requirements applicable to motor cycles.
