Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985

B40 GRENABY ROAD (ARBORY)  
(TEMPORARY WEIGHT RESTRICTION) (NO 2) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 10th June 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made :-

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the B40 Grenaby Road (Arbory) (Temporary Weight Restriction) (No 2) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 10th June 1995.

Temporary Weight Restriction

2. Save as provided in Article 3, no person shall cause any vehicle the gross weight of which, exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in that length of the B40 Grenaby Road from Ballabeg to its junction with B41 Kerrowkeil Road at Grenaby.


Exemptions

3. Nothing in Article 2 shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in that length of the road referred to in that Article if the vehicle is being used with the prior approval of the Department of Transport.

Duration

4. This Order shall continue in force until the 11th June 1995 or until the Isle of Man Steam Packet Road Races practices and races are completed whichever is the earlier.
