SOUTHERN "100" (SUPPLEMENTAL PROVISIONS) ORDER 1995

Coming into Operation: 13th July 1995

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 38 of the Highways Act 1986 (a), and of all other enabling powers, the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and Commencement

1 This Order may be cited as the Southern "100" (Supplemental Provisions) Order 1995 and shall come into operation on the 13th July 1995.

Interpretation

2 In this Order:-

"Clerk of the Course" means the official so designated by the Promoters in the official Programme of the Southern "100" Motorcycle Racing and includes (in the absence of the Clerk of the Course) any Deputy Clerk of the Course so designated;

"closure period" means from the hour of 7.15 p.m. until the hour of 10.45 p.m.;

"Department" means the Department of Transport;

"Promoters" means the Southern "100" Motorcycle Racing Limited;

"scheduled road" means the road set out and described in the Schedule.

Closure of Road and Temporary Suspension and Regulation of Traffic

3 On the 13th July 1995, during the closure period the scheduled road shall be closed to and the right of way thereover suspended, for all vehicular traffic other than such traffic as may be authorised by the Clerk of the Course or by the Chief Constable

Erection of Barriers

4 During the closure period the Promoter may maintain barriers at or near to the junction of the scheduled road with those roads leading into the scheduled road.


Notice of the Making of the Order

5 Public notice of this Order shall be given by advertisement in one Isle of Man newspaper.

The whole of that area of Market Square, Castletown, situated on the Northern side of the Smelt Monument.
