



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**BOROUGH OF DOUGLAS (BATH PLACE)  
(TEMPORARY INTRODUCTION OF ONE-WAY SYSTEM) ORDER 2000**

*Coming into Operation : 4<sup>th</sup> January 2000*

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department by Section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1), the following Order is hereby made:-

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Borough of Douglas (Bath Place) (Temporary Introduction of One-Way System) Order 2000 and shall come into operation at 6.00 a.m. on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2000.

**One-Way Traffic**

2. No person shall, except upon the direction or with permission of a police constable in uniform, cause any vehicle to proceed otherwise than in a westerly direction over Bath Place, Douglas from its junction with Peveril Square to its junction with Lord Street, Douglas.

**Duration**

3. This Order shall continue in force until 8.00 p.m. on Monday 17<sup>th</sup> January 2000 or until the transmission main laying work on Bath Place is completed whichever is the earlier.

The effect of this Order is to temporarily require vehicular traffic to proceed in a westerly direction only over Bath Place whilst transmission main laying work is being undertaken.
