



ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1985

**CHURCH ROAD (PORT ERIN)
(TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2000**

Coming into Operation: 30th March 2000

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Department of Transport by Section 3 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1985 (a), and of all other enabling powers, and after having complied with the procedure set out in Schedule 1 to the Act as required by Section 3(1) the following Order is hereby made:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Church Road (Port Erin) (Temporary Suspension of Parking Places) Order 2000 and shall come into operation at 8.00am on Thursday 30th March 2000.

Temporary suspension of parking

2. No person shall cause any vehicle to be parked on Church Road, Port Erin from its junction with Spaldrick Promenade eastwards for a distance of 50 metres.

Duration

3. This Order shall continue in force until 6.00pm on Monday 8th May 2000.
