*Control of Employment Act 1975*

CONTROL OF EMPLOYMENT (SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS) ORDER 2013

*Approved by Tynwald: 21 February 2013**Coming into Operation: in accordance with article 2*

The Department of Economic Development makes the following Order under section 4(1) of the Control of Employment Act 1975.

1 Title

This Order is the Control of Employment (Secondary School Teachers) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald¹, this Order comes into operation on 1 March 2013.

3 Exemption of secondary school teachers

Subject to article 4 a person employed as a teacher in a secondary school, within the meaning of the Education Act 2001, is exempted from the operation of the Control of Employment Act 1975.

4 Exception for persons with unspent criminal convictions

Article 3 does not apply to a person who has been convicted of an offence and sentenced (anywhere in the world) to a term of custody where —

- (a) the sentence is excluded from rehabilitation by section 2 of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 2001;
- (b) the conviction is not a spent conviction for the purposes of that Act; or
- (c) by virtue of an order under section 10 of that Act, any of the provisions of section 4 of that Act do not apply in relation to —
 - (i) the employment in question, or

- (ii) a question asked in order to assess the suitability of that person for the employment in question.
