*European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973*

GUINEA SANCTIONS (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

Laid before Tynwald: 19 March 2013
Coming into Operation in accordance with regulation 2

The Council of Ministers makes the following Regulations under section 2B of the European Communities (Isle of Man) Act 1973.

1 Title

These Regulations are the Guinea Sanctions (Amendment) Regulations 2013.

2 Commencement

These Regulations come into operation immediately after they are made.

3 Amendment of the Guinea Sanctions Regulations 2010

(1) The Guinea Sanctions Regulations 2010¹ are amended as follows.

(2) In regulation 3 for the definition of “the EU Regulation” substitute—

“the EU Regulation” means Council Regulation (EU) No 1284/2009² of 22 December 2009 imposing certain specific restrictive measures in respect of the Republic of Guinea, as amended by—

- (a) Council Regulation (EU) No 269/2011³ of 21 March 2011 amending Regulation (EU) No 1284/2009 imposing certain specific restrictive measures in respect of the Republic of Guinea;
- (b) Council Regulation (EU) No 1295/2011⁴ of 13 December 2011 amending Regulation (EU) No

- 1284/2009 imposing certain specific restrictive measures in respect of the Republic of Guinea; and
- (c) Council Regulation (EU) No 49/2013 of 22 January 2013⁵ amending Regulation (EU) No 1284/2009 imposing certain specific restrictive measures in respect of the Republic of Guinea,

as these instruments have effect in the Island⁶, and a reference to a numbered Article or Annex (without more) is a reference to the Article of, or Annex to, the EU Regulation so numbered;⁷

4 Revocation

The Guinea Sanctions (Amendment) Regulations 2012⁷ are revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Guinea Sanctions Regulations 2010 (SD 563/10: “the Principal Regulations”) to take account of the amendment of Council Regulation(EU) No 1284/2009, as applied to the Island by the European Union (Guinea Sanctions) (Application) Order 2010 (SD 561/10), by Council Regulation (EU) No 49/2013 as applied to the Island by the European Union (Guinea Sanctions) (Application) (Amendment) Order 2013 (SD 0099/13). The Principal Regulations established offences and penalties for breaches of Council Regulation (EU) No. 1284/2009, as applied to the Island by SD 561/10, and they provided for the licensing by the Treasury of certain activities.
