Dangerous Goods Act 1928

DANGEROUS GOODS (FEES) ORDER 2013

Approved by Tynwald: 16 April 2013
Coming into Operation: 1 May 2013

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 4(1)(e) of the Dangerous Goods Act 1928.

1 Title

This Order is the Dangerous Goods (Fees) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

If approved by Tynwald, this Order comes into operation on 1 May 2013¹.

3 Licence fees

Subject to article 4, the fee payable for any licence required under the Act for keeping any dangerous goods is calculated in accordance with the Schedule.

4 Exemptions

No fee is payable in respect of a licence issued to a charitable organisation principally concerned with the preservation or saving of life.

5 Revocation

The Dangerous Goods (Fees) Order 2009² is revoked.

LICENCE FEES

(for a licence with a term of up to 12 months)

Fee for a licence to keep petroleum spirit in a quantity -	£
Not exceeding 2,500 litres	45.00
Exceeding 2,500 litres but not exceeding 50,000 litres	87.50
Exceeding 50,000 litres	175.00
Fee for a licence to keep any explosives (including fireworks) in a quantity -	£
Not exceeding 10 kilograms	30.00
Exceeding 10 kilograms but not exceeding 2,500 kilograms	45.00
Exceeding 2,500 kilograms but not exceeding 50,000 kilograms	87.50
Exceeding 50,000 kilograms	175.00

This Order revokes the Dangerous Goods (Fees) Order 2009 (SD 136/09) and makes provision for inflationary increases to the fees payable for licenses issued under the Dangerous Goods Act 1928.
