ROAD VEHICLES, MAINTENANCE & USE (CLASSIC CARS SPRINT AND HILL CLIMBS) ORDER 2013

Made: 10 April 2013
Coming into Operation: 23 April 2013

The Department of Infrastructure makes the following Order under section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1985.

1 Title

This Order is the Road Vehicles, Maintenance & Use (Classic Cars Sprint and Hill Climbs) Order 2013.

2 Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 23 April 2013.

3 Interpretation

In this Order—

“Clerk of the Course,” “closure period”, “promoter” and “race area” have the same meanings as in the Road Race Order;

“Road Race Orders” means the Governor’s Sprint (Douglas) Order 2013, Sloc Hill Climb, Rushen Order 2013 and Lhergy Frissell Hill Climb, Ramsey Order 2013.

4 Authorisation of use of certain motor cars

(1) This article applies to a motor car taking part in any Road Race Orders which does not comply with all the requirements of the Road Vehicles (Maintenance and Use) Regulations 2002, as amended, insofar as those provisions apply to the requirements relating to tyres and lighting of a motor vehicle specified in (2), are suspended for the periods specified in paragraph (3).

(2) The use on roads of a motor vehicle which is competing in a Road Race or practice authorised by article 4 of the Road Race Orders, or is being

driven by a marshal in the course of his duty with the permission of the Clerk of the Course, and is being used on a journey –

- (a) travelling to and from the Sea Terminal; or
- (b) travelling from the place where it is kept to the start of the race area.
- (c) travelling from a point on the race area to the place where it is kept;

is subject to the restrictions and conditions specified in paragraph (3).

- (3) The authorisation applies to daylight hours between sunrise and sunset and during a period commencing 3 hours before the closure period applicable to the race referred to in paragraph (1) and ending 3 hours after that closure period providing that the race period falls outside the lighting-up period.

5 Duration

This Order will continue in force for the period 23 April until 29 April 2013.

This Order authorises the use on a road to or from a race area forming part of the Classic Cars Sprint and Hill Climbs Orders 2013 of a motor car taking part in the race, although it may not comply with the construction, lighting and tyre requirements applicable to motor cars between 23 April and 29 April 2013.
